## MONTHLY FUNDRAISING

All families are required to fundraise a profit of \$65.00 a month for their family account. This amount helps to cover our program costs as outlined by our annually prepared budget. Each fundraiser is carefully vetted to get the maximum profit to our cadets.

Cadets also have their own individual accounts. Once their monthly requirement is met, a cadet can fundraise directly for their own accounts. This account gets used for our larger cadet trips or can be used as requested towards future monthly family account requirements.

## Ongoing Fundraising

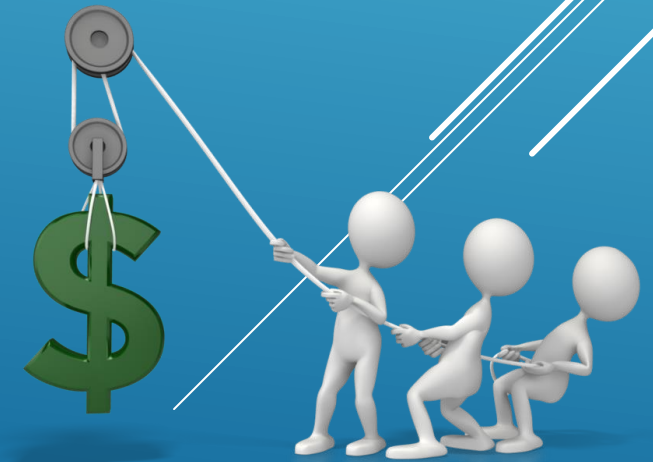
- ▶ Ongoing Chocolate Covered Almonds (one case covers the \$45.00 for the month)

All Cash / Cheques **Must** Be Placed In An Envelope At Branch Table Labeled With Cadet Name And Fundraiser Identification.

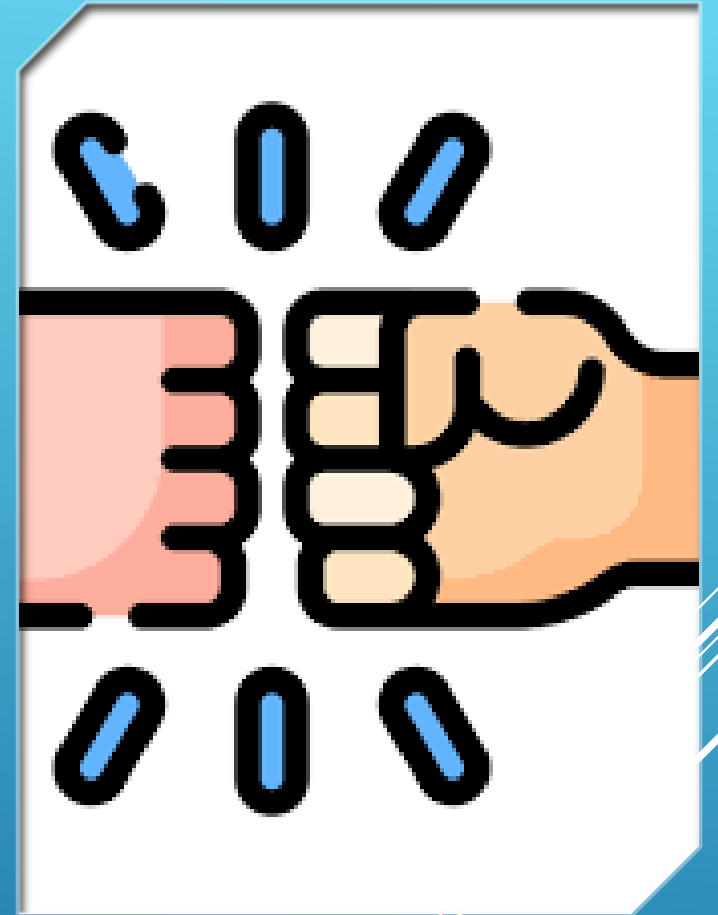
